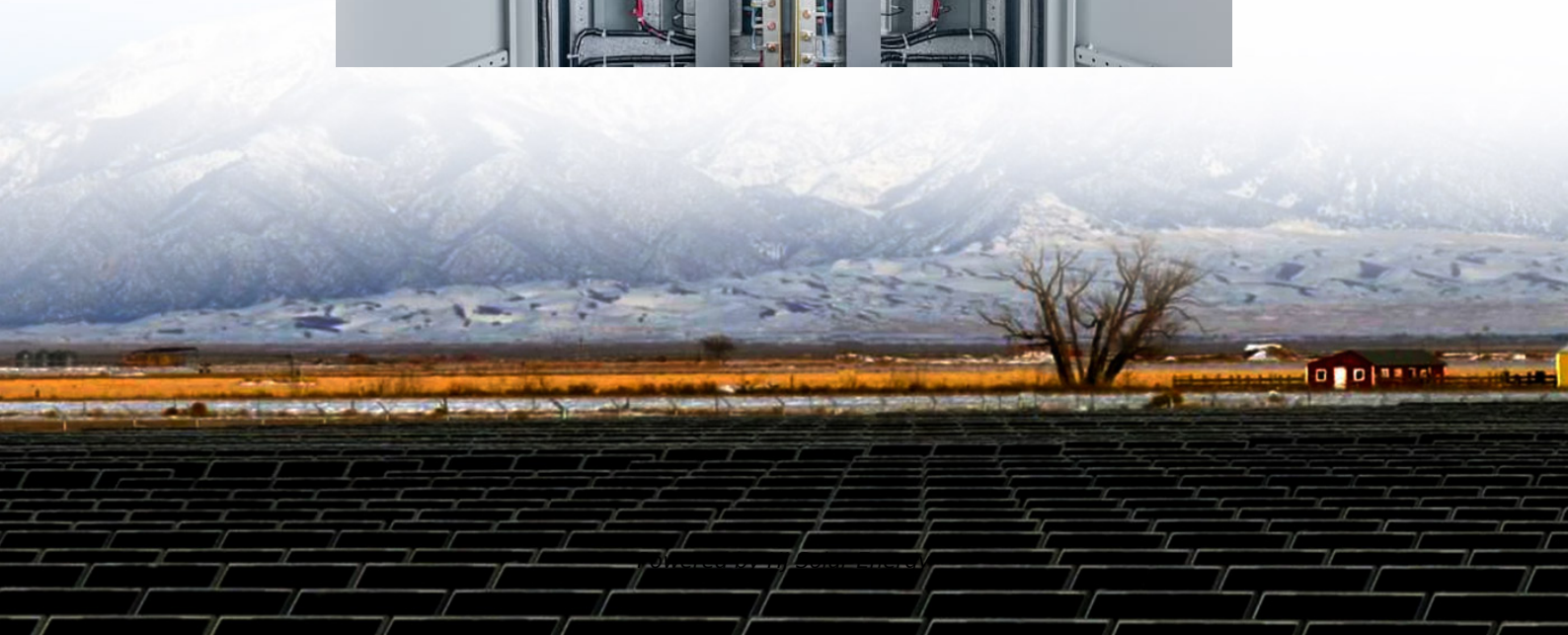


7dtd using solar panels to recharge battery bank

My setup: Solar Bank (117w max) > Battery Bank (300w max) > Base (137w)
Obviously, my solar bank is underpowered right now. However, even with this setup, if I have my solar bank switched on, it will draw the max (117w) from it



and then nothing from the battery bank. Is it supposed to work that way.

So my problem is, I connected the Solar Bank with the Battery Bank and connected some blade traps and motion sensors to it. the max output of my solar bank couldn't compare all traps at the same time, so I was hoping the Battery Bank would compare the rest but it isn't. Only the solar Bank is in. Can you use solar panels in 7 days to die?

Let's get started. In 7 Days to Die, you can use Solar Panels and Battery Banks to create a power supply system for your base. Solar Panels, also called Solar Banks, are non-craftable items that are hard to come by. You can only buy them from Traders, and they usually cost 4,500 Dukes per unit.

How to recharge a battery bank?

In order to recharge a Battery Bank, you need to connect it with an external power source such as Solar Bank or a Generator. You can attach this external power source to the battery bank by using a wire tool. Using a wire tool, first right click on the power source and then again on the bank. This will connect both items.

Can a battery bank be connected to a solar bank?

If you connect the Battery Bank to an external power source and turn it on, this will cause the bank to recharge its batteries. If no batteries are added, then the bank in between will only act as a relay that can pass power from the external source, down multiple output lines. A good design would be to pair the Battery Bank with a Solar Bank.

Does a battery bank provide power?

When there is an active power source such as a solar bank or generator, the battery bank does not provide power. In fact, the battery bank will draw 5w to recharge any batteries that are not full. The battery bank capacity only comes into play when the solar bank or generator are not providing power.

How many Dukes can a solar bank charge?

By the time you have barter 5 a solar bank will set you back 10,000-50,000 Dukes. Up to six Solar Cell can be placed inside the Solar Bank. If hooked up directly to a Battery Bank they will slowly recharge it during the day. The Solar Bank is not able to have any parent connection. Only outgoing power lines are allowed.



How does a battery bank work?

An externally powered and turned on Battery Bank will recharge its batteries. If there are no batteries installed it acts as a relay pushing power down line.
