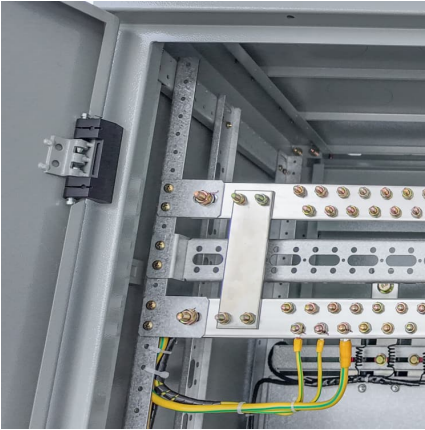


Add milwaukee battery m18 add power to solar generator

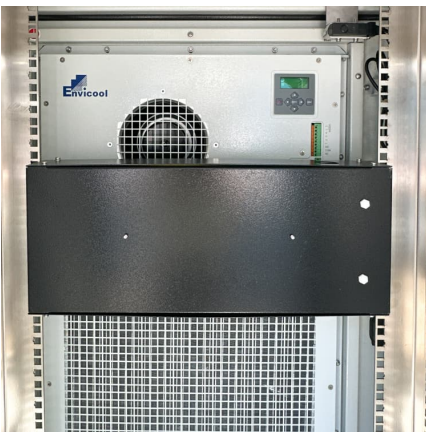

Here is how to charge your Milwaukee, DeWalt, Makita, or other 12V, 18V, or 20V power tool batteries using solar power without an inverter.



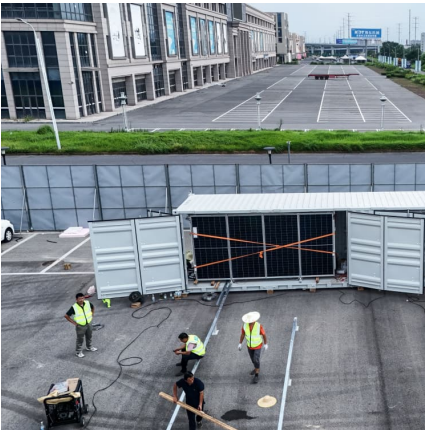
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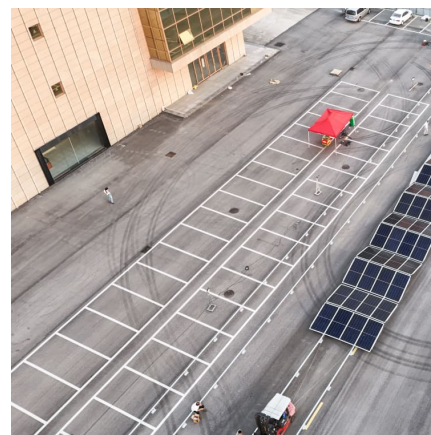


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
