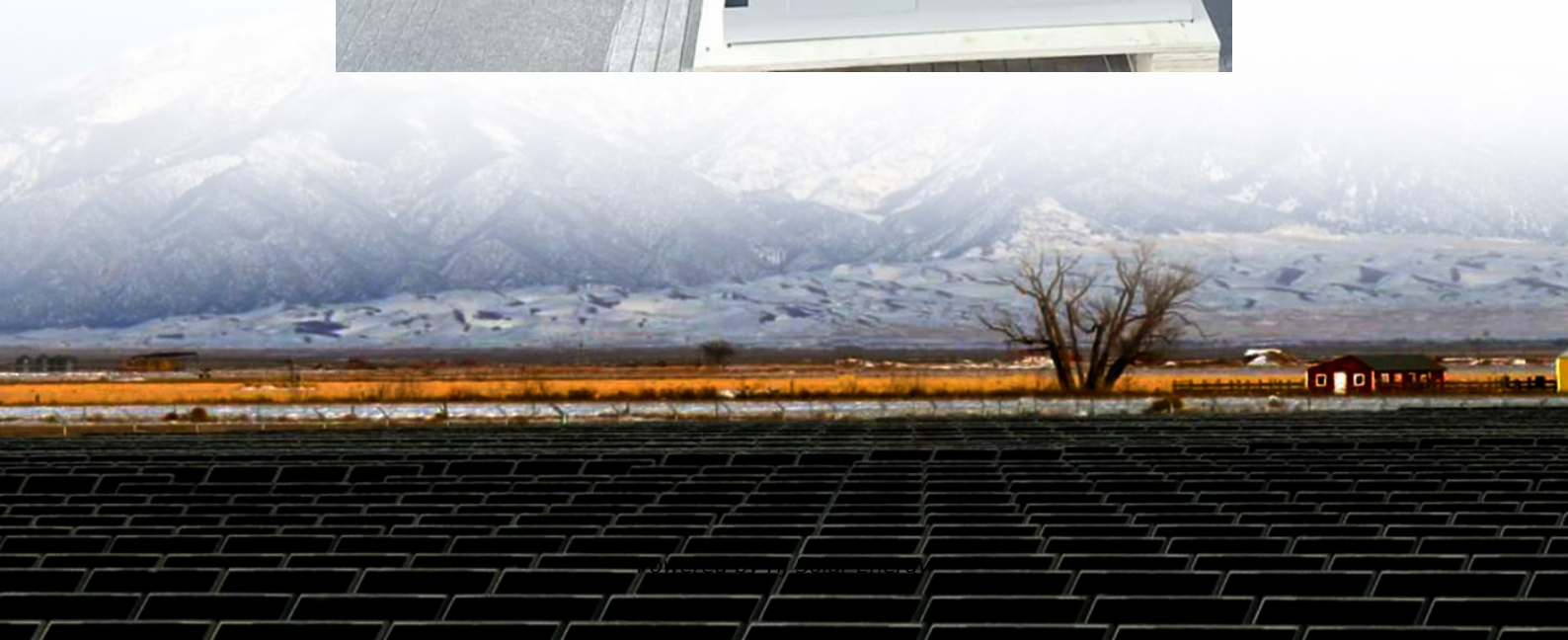

Eminent domain entitles the government to take land for public use. Property owners are rarely successful in stopping governments from taking their property under eminent domain. The U.S. Constitution does give property owners the right to "just compensation," however. Property owners can dispute.

Can the government take private land for public use?

The government can take private land for public use through a power known as eminent domain. This authority, rooted in the U.S. Constitution, allows federal, state, and local governments to acquire property from private owners.

Are state lands taxable?

However, certain lands owned by the State are taxable for specific taxing purposes pursuant to Sections 532, 533, 534 and 536 of the Real Property Tax Law and Section 15-2115 of the Environmental Conservation Law. Locally determined assessments of taxable State land are reviewed by the Office of Real Property Tax Services (ORPTS) annually.

What is federally owned land?

Federally owned land includes national parks, national monuments, national forests, and national historic battlefields, as well as wildlife refuges and military reservations. The states own and manage about nine percent of the total U.S. land area with state forests, state parks and state wildlife management areas.

Can you take a lot from state/federal land?

In some areas, you can take quite a lot from state/federal land (if it's for personal use only), with some activities requiring permits. Public land managed by BLM and USFS, as well as most state agencies, allows the public to remove certain items, but they expect visitors to not damage the land or vegetation.

Who manages land in the United States?

Among the states, management falls to agencies like the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) or the Department of Environmental Protection



(DEP). The United States government is the largest landowner in the country, controlling almost a third of total U.S. land area.



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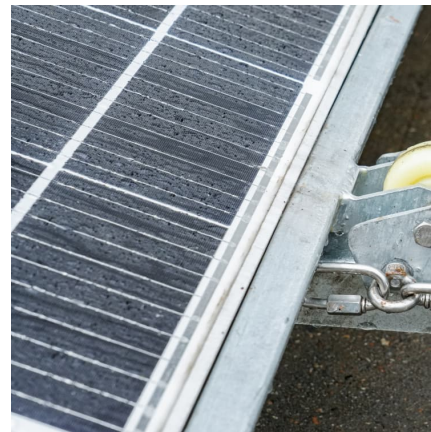
