Overview

Lithium ion batteries installed in a personal electronic device can be transported as checked or carry-on baggage. Lithium ion batteries not installed in a device (spares) must be in carry-on baggage and no more than two (2) spares between 100 and 160-watt hours are allowed.

Lithium-ion (rechargeable) batteries and portable batteries that contain lithium-ion can only be packed in carry-on baggage. They're limited to a rating of 100 watt hours (Wh) per battery. With airline approval, you can bring two larger spare batteries (up to 160 Wh). Here are our favorite battery. Can you carry a battery on Delta Airlines?

Delta Airlines restricts passengers from bringing defective batteries or items that manufacturers have recalled. You are permitted to carry spare batteries in carry-on luggage. However, to ensure battery safety, Delta Airlines recommends that you place batteries in their original packaging before placing them in carry-on luggage.

Does Delta Airlines allow Smart bags without batteries?

Delta Airlines does not allow smart bags without removable batteries in checked baggage. However, if the battery is removable, you can bring it as carry-on luggage on the flight. Furthermore, it is expected that you take out the batteries from the smart bag before boarding the plane.

How many batteries can Delta Airlines take?

Notably, no more than two spares between 100 and 160 watt-hours are permitted. Also, Delta Airlines allows lithium metal batteries as long as each battery contains a maximum of 2 grams of lithium content. Why are Airlines so Concerned with Batteries?

Are batteries allowed in checked baggage?

These batteries are usually considered as "spare" or "loose" and are not allowed in checked baggage. However, portable electronic devices, such as power banks or solar generators, with a watt-hour rating below 100 Wh are generally permitted in carry-on and checked baggage, following specific guidelines.

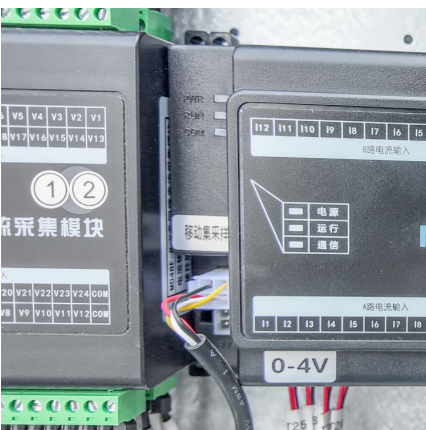

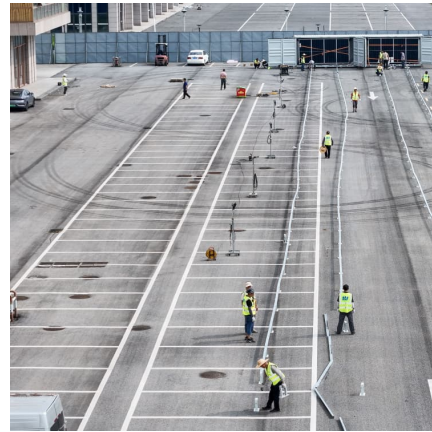
