Some batteries, like Lithium-ion batteries used in electronic devices, are allowed in checked luggage. But some batteries with a high risk of explosion, like lithium metal batteries, are not permitted in checked luggage. So it's essential to know the rules and regulations about specific batteries that airlines and TSA apply.

Are batteries allowed on a plane?

n batteries are allowed in your carry on based on watt hours (Wh). Batter-ies 0-100 Wh are allowed on passenger aircraft, 101-160 Wh require ir carrier approval, and batteries exceeding 160 Wh are forbidden. There are additional safety requirements and limitations when placing batteries in checked bags or hen.

Can you bring a battery if it's recalled?

Damage is usually straightforward. If you have a battery that is busted up that won't be allowed. But you also are not allowed to bring batteries that have been recalled or that have a tendency to create sparks or generate a dangerous evolution of heat. These are not allowed in your carry-on or checked bag.

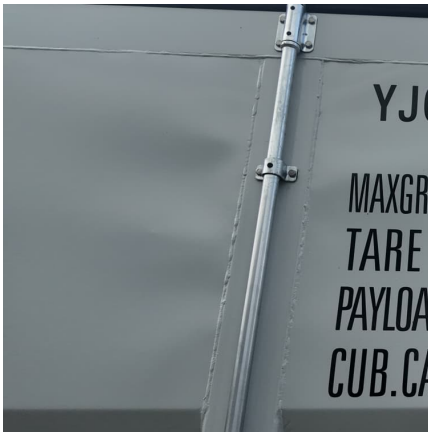

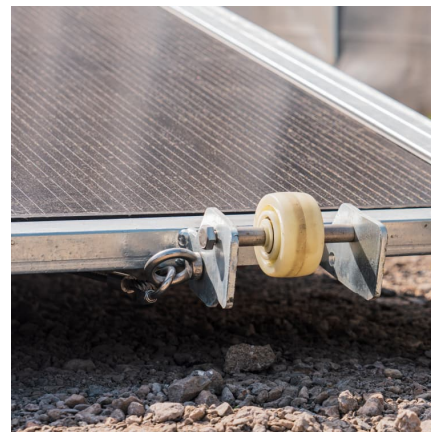
