Shared Solar enables residential customers living in multifamily dwellings (apartments, condominiums, duplexes) to fix a portion of their electric bill against rising utility costs for 10 years, as well as support renewable energy, help create local jobs, help reduce the carbon footprint of LADWP's.

This resource offers a compilation of various rebates to support: fire resilient buildings; fire resilient and water efficient landscapes; cool roofs; rooftop photovoltaic (i.e., solar), electric vehicle charging, and battery storage; and energy and water efficient buildings, including equipment.

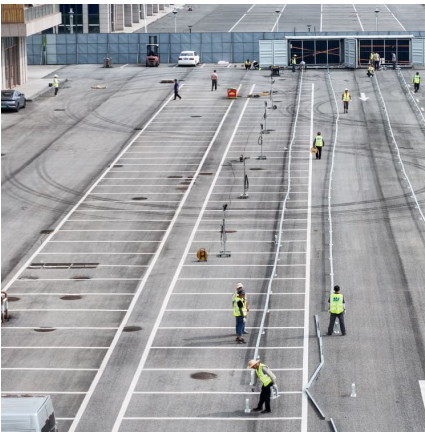
