We have a newly-acquired Winnie Adventurer 37G with a dual gas/electric water heater. Both sources work the heater, but if we leave either source switched on for more than an hour or so, scalding water starts being ejected from what appears to be a pressure relief valve. I presume it's a thermostat.

I use electric heat probably 98% of the time, but I experience the same water temperature on either energy source. Be aware that if you set the temperature too low, you'll be using relatively more water from your heater tank and potentially run out of hot water sooner. So, find a happy setting that.

The water gets too hot (scalding). I cannot find a thermostat anywhere. I've been manually shutting it off after about 5 minutes, but that gets very old. Any ideas?

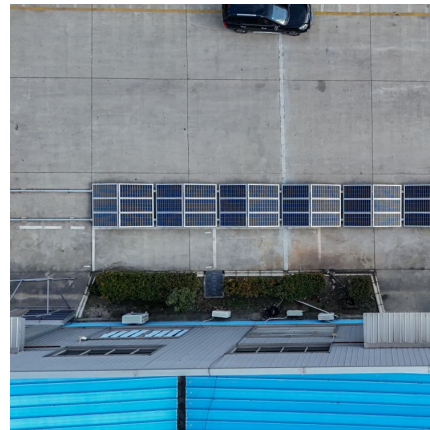

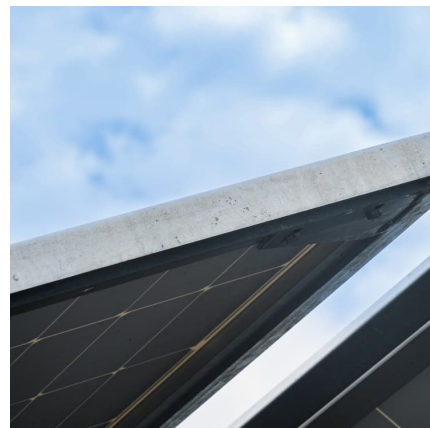

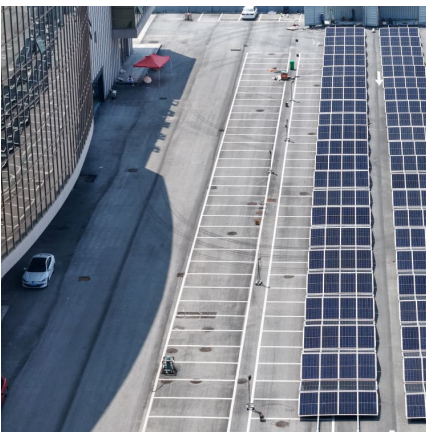
